

## ONE ON ONE MENTORSHIP A stipend for choreographers living in Freiburg

As part of the TANZPAKT fund supporting new dance initiatives in Freiburg and a three year vision to support the professional development of local choreographers, stipends of 1,400€ each will be awarded to two choreographers in 2020.

Choreographers are invited to identify and design their own vision of the mentorship they need. Applicants will be asked to describe where they are currently in their career, what they most need support and mentorship on and to envision a plan of mentorship that would help them further their aims.

**Who.** Two Choreographers living in Freiburg

**What.** 1,400€ per choreographer to be used for the Mentor including travel costs

**When.** Deadline to apply is 24.05.2019

Applicants will know the results by 08.06.2019

For the selected choreographers the stipend must be used between 08.06. and 31.12.2020

In early 2021 the two choreographers will be asked to share their experiences with the community in a public sharing.

- # Describe where you are currently in your career.  
including 1-2 video links of your current works.
- # Describe what you feel you are most lacking and in what part of your dance  
making you feel you most need mentorship on.
- # Create a plan for how you imagine your mentorship to unfold, being specific  
as possible and including a timeline and budgetplan for the 1,400€
- # Please send your CV along with the application.

It is highly recommended that you research and try to find a mentor before applying. If you feel you need support in finding a mentor, describe the type of mentor you are looking for and we will try to find someone who will be a good fit.
